## The Week at a Glance: August 9 – 13

The current situation is looking bad, and it will likely get worse before it gets better. The US is now averaging over 120,000 new Covid-19 infections per day, and nearly 4,000 people suffered Covid-19 related deaths over the last week. Oregon is seeing more than 2,000 new case per day, and hospitalizations are straining the health system. A recent OHSU model shows that Oregon will be short 400 to 500 hospital beds by Labor day. The Delta variant is two to three time more transmissible than other variants. Delta infects 8 people for every one that is positive, compared to only 3 for the other strains. Delta is driving the increase in positive cases, and the spread of Delta among the unvaccinated is driving the increasing hospitalizations, and deaths.

To date, Virginia Garcia has fully vaccinated more than 25,000 people. Also remember that all of those things (masks, hand hygiene, distancing, avoiding crowds, and now vaccines) that worked earlier in the pandemic still work. If you or somebody you know has not yet been vaccinated, it is a really good time to go get it.

### Covid-19 Highlights & Reminders

- August 4, Governor Brown mandated that all healthcare staff be fully vaccinated against Covid-19 by September 30.
- Confirmed patient COVID-19 cases and presumptive COVID-19 cases are required to:
  - Isolate for at least 10 days after illness onset and until 24 hours after fever is gone, without use of antipyretics, and COVID-19 symptoms (cough, shortness of breath, and diarrhea) are improving.
  - Isolate for at least 10 days after the collection date of the specimen that tested positive if asymptomatic or only with symptoms other than fever, cough, shortness of breath and diarrhea.
  - Isolate for at least 20 days if suffering from severe to critical illness related to COVID19, if hospitalized for COVID-19, or if the individual has a severely compromised immune system.
- Patient close contacts are required to:
  - Quarantine by staying home and at least six (6) feet away from everyone, including household members.
  - A 14-day quarantine is the safest option to prevent the spread of COVID-19 to others.

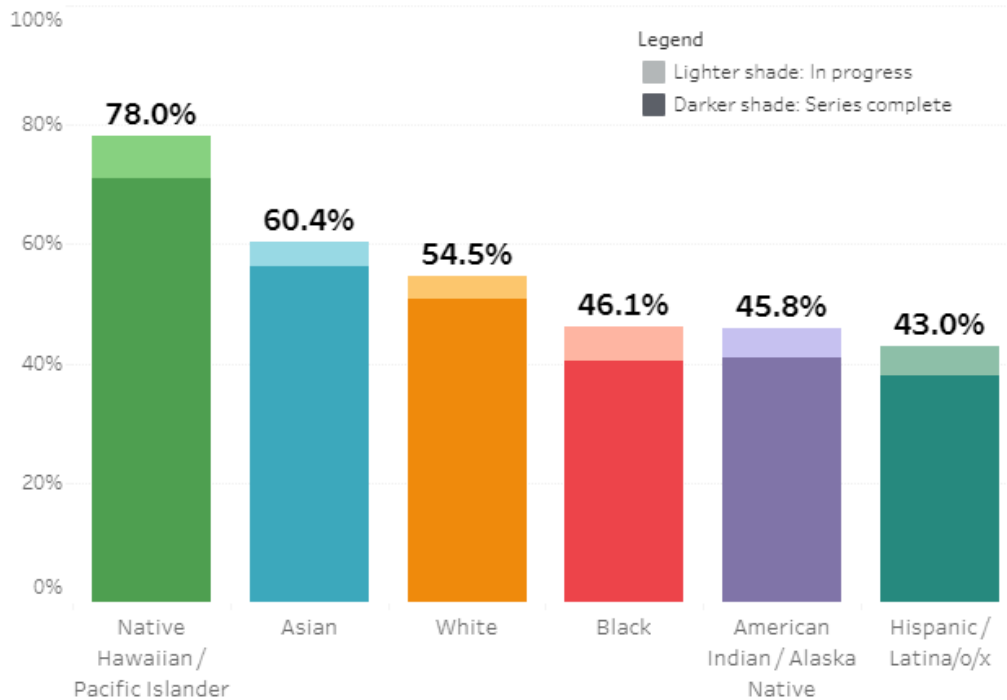
